

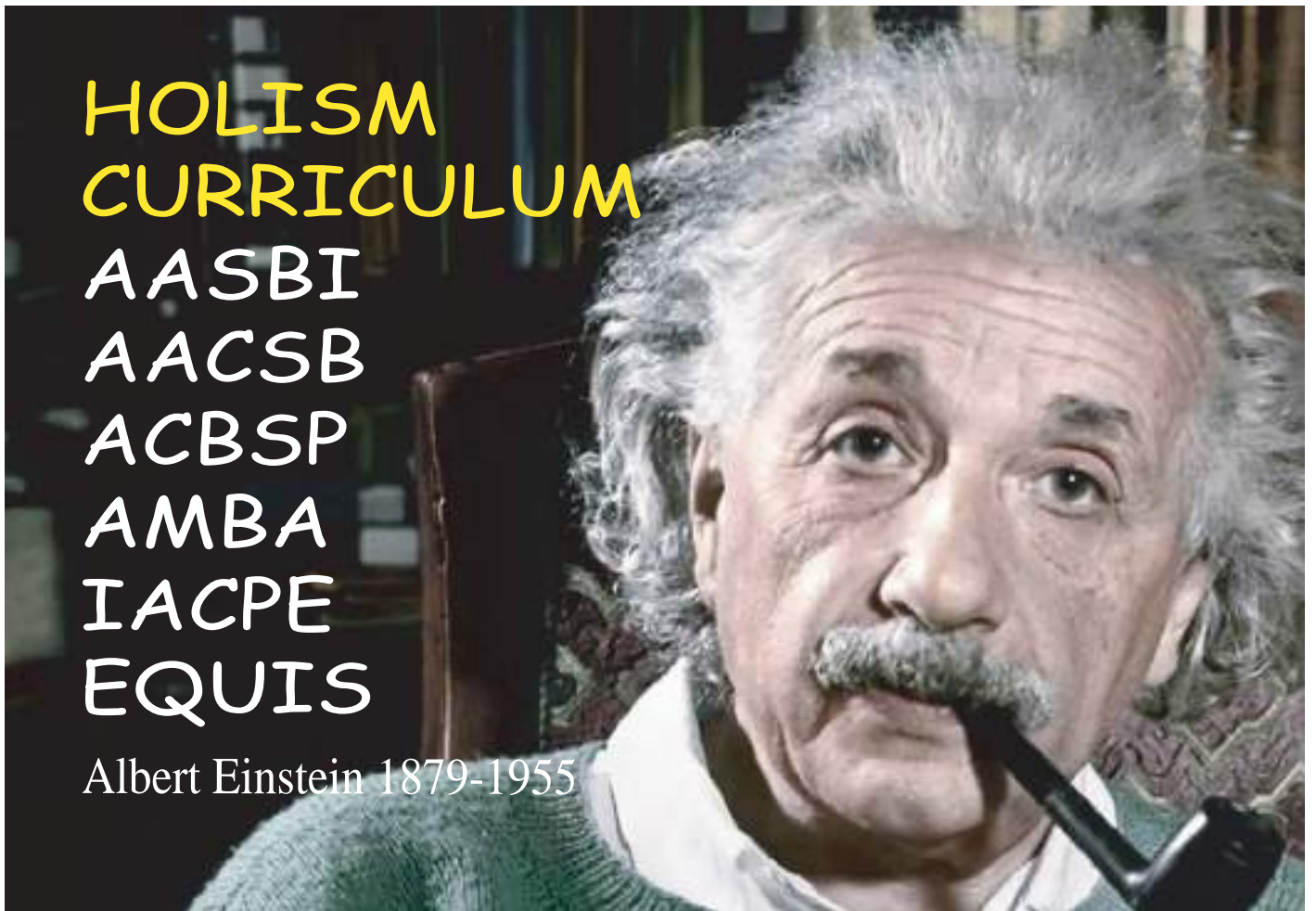

**Albert Einstein** believed that education should not be limited to theoretical knowledge but should also focus on its practical application. He emphasized the importance of connecting classroom learning to real-world experiences and challenges. (Google March 20, 2024)



**Jan Christan Smuts** (1870-1955) had written the Constitution of the League of Nations (after World War 1), and the Preamble to the United Nations Charter (after World War 2). Winston Churchill once declared that "my faith in him is unbreakable". Woodrow Wilson admired him "extravagantly". Albert Einstein said that he was one of the few men who understood the theory of relativity. He would meet John Maynard Keynes in the evenings, and "we (would) rail against the world". Nelson Mandela praised his contribution to "promoting freedom throughout the world". But perhaps the most apt quote comes from Lord Todd, the Master of Christ's College, Cambridge, who said that in the 500 years of the College's history, of all its members, past and present, three had been truly outstanding: John Milton, Charles Darwin and Jan Smuts.

"**Holism and Evolution**" is a 1926 book by South African statesman Jan Smuts, in which he coined the word "holism", although Smuts' meaning differs from the modern concept of holism. Smuts defined holism as the "fundamental factor operative towards the creation of wholes in the universe." In 1948, he was elected Chancellor of the University of Cambridge, becoming the first person from outside the United Kingdom to hold that position. He held the position until his death two years later.

**AASBI Business Accreditation Standards** are positions in the "Generally Accepted Education Principles" (GAEP) and the "Generally Accepted Educational Standards on Auditing" (GAESA) 156 pages in 2011 as of public domain in the United States and States parties to the Marid Convention ISBN-13 978-1460971369), also avail as a PDF on the AASBI's websites'.



The AASBI's Accreditation Standards are compiled in the form as Self-Accredit and Confirmatio Progress as application by the College or University as a so-called "Checklist and Affirmation" with 26 items, which will be filed-in, form and signed by the emailed to the AASBI and normally accepted by the way of affirmation and accepted by the AASBI Accredited college or university's School of Business Administration faculty by the Dean(s) and co-operaty signed by the executive leadership as a President, Vice President Academic Affairs, Chancellor or otherwise. The acceptance of the AASBI Accreditation college / university's certificates and sent to School of Business's Deans at free on charge, subject to a reasonable annual dues transferred to the AASBI executive's by the Schhho of Business.

The AASBI do not expect the colleges and universities to provide for information of any party of curricula, accepting the universities' complete holistic educations of freedom, as Albert Einstein believed, that education should not be limited to theoretical knowledge but should also focus on its practical application. **Ivy League** founded as the Group "American Assembly of Collegiate Schools of Business" (AACSB) in 1916, namely seven of the eight private members of the Ivy League as Brown University established 1754, Columbia University in 1754 as the King's College, Cornell University in 1864, Dartmouth College in 1769, Harvard College in 1636, University of Pennsylvania in 1751, Princeton University as the College of New Jersey 1746, and Yale University as Collegiate School in 1701.

Wikipedia's list on #Rank Overall of their Ivey's endowments FY2023 are: #1 Harvard \$50 billion, #3 Yale \$40 bn, #4 Stanford \$36 bn, #5 Princeton \$35 bn, #6 MIT \$23 bn, #7 U. of Pennsylvania \$21 bn, #11 Notre Dame \$17 bn, #12 and #13 of Northwestern and Columbia \$14 bn, #14 Duke \$13, etc.

The Schools of Business Schools as mentioned above, are not accredited by the AACSB in 1916 by the Ivey League's Universities' being the creation of the AACSB, but in effectively the opposite. And the Ivey League's are the highest endowment universities at far, also from the largest cities of the wealthiest areas, namely, Boston of Massachusetts, Great New York City, Chicago, Texas, and California.

The universities are also the highest endowment research, receiving their funds from including Apples, Microsoft, IBM, HP, Shell, Amazon, JP Morgan, UBS, Nestle, Pepsi-Cola, Hofmann-La Roche, SC Johnson, etc. being the MNC Multinational Corporations. Endowment funds are not created by AACSB's accreditation's universities, by the AASBI who certification, publishing and its donations of the MNC Multination Corporations.

AACSB may increase accreditations of universities of their enrollments, and their tuitions, to process that includes a rigorous external review of a school's mission, faculty qualifications, curricula, and ability to provide the highest-quality programs. But the results may become along with their enrollments, and may be always not. As Einstein believed that, education should not be limited to theoretical knowledge but should also focus on its practical application.
